



Parent and Spectator Guidelines Active as of November 1, 2020

Spectators at the Arena:

- ***Spectators must wear masks at all times inside the arena facilities as per the City of Lethbridge Temporary Mandatory Face Covering Bylaw #6239.***
- A maximum of 50 spectators for each ice session will be accommodated **with an exception for ticketed or controlled events as approved by the City of Lethbridge at Nicholas Sheran and ATB Centre arenas only. In those approved situations, a maximum will be set at 75 spectators.**
- Spectators are asked to only stay for their booking and clear the facility as quickly as possible after the session is over.
- **Arenas will allow spectators to sit in any available seating around the ice surface, without restrictions to zones, to increase the ability of spectators to socially distance (please follow arena specific guidelines when attending the Enmax Centre). This will reduce the capacity of arena staff to clean all areas after each ice use. With this in mind, spectators should increase their personal sanitization measures including hand washing or use of hand sanitizers.**
- Spectators are required to maintain social distancing (2m) whenever possible **even with the use of face masks.**
- As per the Guidance for Sport, Physical Activity and Recreation – Stage 2 Provincial documents. Cheering and yelling is strongly discouraged.
- **In order for our facilities to comply with Provincial guidelines it is essential that spectators follow facility signage when exiting the ice area. Most arenas require spectators to exit at different locations than they entered.**

Assisting Athletes in Change Rooms:

- One parent or caregiver will be allowed to assist an athlete in the change room area.
- Assist the athlete and then immediately exit the change room area. Do not stay in the room to visit or socialize with athletes, coaches or other parents.
- **If alternate exits are indicated by facility signage, it is essential those exits are utilized to avoid exceeding provincial guidelines for gathering numbers in lobbies or areas where people congregate.**
- Each booking will be assigned two change rooms. If only one team is using the ice slot both change rooms may be used to try and provide as much social distancing as possible. If two teams are participating, one change room per team should be used.
- Masks are mandatory for everyone, at all times inside the facility **including while in the change room area.** The only exceptions are when a helmet is put on and the athlete heads to the ice surface or when using shower amenities.
- Please note that it is highly recommended that athletes arrive fully dressed. Change rooms are limited to 30 minutes before bookings and 30 minutes after ice sessions.
